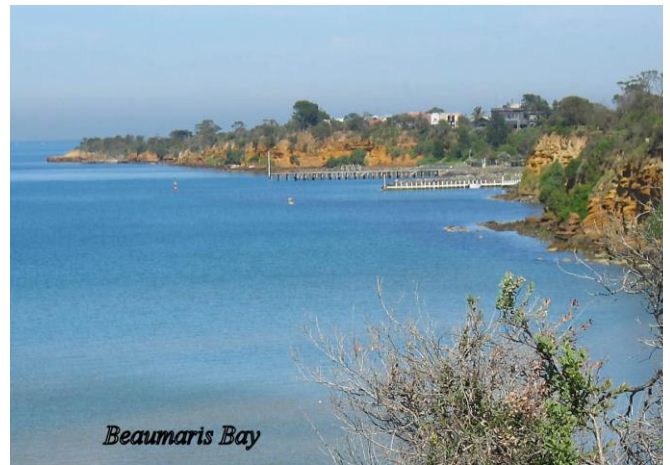

On Monday June 3, for our visit to the Bendigo Art Gallery to see the "Tudors to Windsors: British Royal Portraits" exhibition we will catch the 9.11 am train from Cheltenham (9.09 am Mentone, 9.07 am Parkdale and 9.04 Mordialloc) to Southern Cross. Here we will catch the 10.20 am V-line train to Bendigo (arriving at 12.07 pm) and walk (about 15 minutes from the station) or catch a bus to the Gallery. I will book lunch at the Gallery Café for 12.30 pm and have booked entry to the Gallery at 2.00 pm (we will possibly be allowed to enter earlier).
